

Separation and Disposal of Recyclables and Garbage

- ◎Be punctual for the time and day to take out garbage.
- ◎The usual collection will take place even if the collection day is a holiday. But, there is no collection on Saturdays, Sundays, and Year-end and New Year holidays.
- ◎Take out the garbage in the designated garbage collection site in your neighborhood by 8:00 AM.
- ◎You can't take out garbage from businesses and workplaces.

The Cleaning Center is closed on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.

However, on the first Saturday of each month that is not a holiday and the third Sunday that is not a holiday, reception is open from 8:30 to 16:30(excluding the lunch break).

The handling fee for self-delivery to the Cleaning Center is 157 yen per 10 kg.

Burnable Garbage Twice a week . 	1	Burnable Garbage	●Soiled paper (tissue paper, laminated paper, disposable diapers, etc.) ●Non-recyclable leather and fabric products (bags, shoes, etc.) ●Plastics, rubber, vinyl items (Polyethylene plastic jerrycans(up to 18L), cassette tapes, video tapes) ●Food waste ●Wood products, fallen leaves, pruned branches (up to 50cm in length)	★When disposing of trash at a garbage collection site, use the designated bags (green) or disposal tickets. ★If you bring it to the cleaning center yourself, you don't need to use the designated bags. A separate processing fee will be charged. ●Designated bags must be within 10kg for 40L and 5kg for 20L. ●For items that do not fit into the designated bags, please use a disposal ticket. Tie up items up to 50cm in length with string, and keep the weight to 10kg or less. ●Drain food waste thoroughly. ●Don't mix dangerous materials (explosives) or "Non-Burnable Garbage".
Recyclables and Non-Burnable Garbage Every month ○ th (No.2~11)	2	Colorless Bottles	A colorless,transparent bottle for food and drink (1.8L bottle, milk bottles, vinegar, salad dressing, jam, etc.)	★Remove the caps, wash them with water, sort them by color, and throw them away in containers at the collection center. ●Metal bottle caps and can lids should be disposed of as "Aluminum cans/Steel cans." ●Dispose of broken bottles with the "Glass".
	3	Brown Bottles	Brown bottle for food and drink (beer bottle, energy drinks, medication, etc.)	
	4	Other Colored Bottles	Bottles of other colors(green, blue, black, etc.) for food and drink(wine, whiskey, shochu, etc.)	
	5	Pottery	Tableware such as bowls and plates, clay pots, jars, tins, ceramics, mortars, flower pots	
	6	Glass	Glass containers(cups,tableware,vases,ashtrays,etc.), cosmetic bottles, broken bottles, broken glass	★Throw it in a bucket at the garbage collection site. ●Glass containers (cups, plates, baby bottles, vases, ashtrays, etc.) and cosmetic bottles should be disposed of as "Glass" regardless of color.
	7	Batteries	Batteries(dry cell batteries, button/coin batteries, rechargeable batteries, lithium batteries, etc.)	
	8	Fluorescent Lights	Fluorescent lights (straight type/ring type)	
	9	Non-Burnable Garbage	Lighters, light bulbs, mirrors, flameless lighter, mobile batteries, thermometers(containing mercury)	
	10	Plastic Bottles	Plastic bottles	
	11	Plastic Bottle Caps	Plastic bottle caps	
	12	Styrofoam Trays ▪ Styrofoam	Styrofoam tray, styrofoam	★Remove the labels and caps, wash them with water, crush them as much as possible, and dispose of them in a net at a collection point. ●The caps should be thrown into the collection bucket. ●The labels should be thrown away as "Burnable Garbage." ●Wash the styrofoam trays with water and drain them before throwing them away. ●Dispose of stained trays and other items that cannot be cleaned as "Burnable Garbage".
	13	Newspapers ▪ Flyers	Newspapers, flyers	★Organize the garbage by type and dispose of it at a garbage collection site. ●Newspapers, magazines, and cardboard should be bundled together by type and tied with string. ●Place items of different sizes together in a paper bag.
	14	Magazines	Magazines, books, notebooks, comic books, picture books, pamphlets, catalogs	
	15	Other Papers	Wrapping paper, paper bags, confectionery boxes, tissue boxes, business cards, copy paper	
	16	Cardboard	Cardboard	  ●Open the cartons, dry them and then tie them up. ●Paper cartons with a silver or brown interior should be disposed of as "Burnable Garbage."
	17	Paper Cartons	Milk cartons, juice boxes, paper cartons for alcohol	
	18	Old Clothes ▪ Blankets	Suits, shirts, sweaters, underwear, socks, ties, sheets, bath towels, blankets	
	19	Aluminum Cans ▪ Steel Cans	Aluminum cans, steel cans, candy cans, spray cans	★Place in a transparent or semi-transparent plastic bag and dispose of at a collection point. ●If it is dirty, dispose of it as "Burnable Garbage". ★Rinse with water and dispose of at a garbage collection site. ●Empty the contents of spray cans, punch a hole in them and throw them away at the garbage collection site. ●If one side is over 50cm or the weight exceeds 10kg, it is treated as "Large Garbage."
	20	Other Metals	Pots, frying pans, non-aluminum/steel cans, machine oil cans, rice cookers, power cords, umbrellas, small electronics with circuit boards or built-in batteries(including toys)	
Large Garbage (Paid Service) ※Even if it is dismantled, it will not be collected	21	Large Garbage	Home appliances(other than items in Division 22), furniture, tires, extinguishers, mopeds(50cc or less), futons, carpets, electric blankets, gas ranges, diatomaceous mats	★Bring it to the cleaning center yourself or request collection at your home. ●For door-to-door collection, please call the Cleaning Center (additional fees apply). ●Even if "Large Garbage" is disassembled, it cannot be disposed of as recyclable waste.
	22	Electric Household Recycling	TV, air conditioner, washer, dryer, refrigerator (including freezer)	★Bring it to the Cleaning Center yourself or request collection at your home. ①Purchase a "Home Appliance Recycling Ticket" in advance at the post office and take the items to the Cleaning Center yourself. ⇒ The fee to be paid to the Cleaning Center is 2,100 yen per item. ② Purchase a "Home Appliance Recycling Ticket" in advance at the post office and request the Cleaning Center to collect the items from your home. ⇒ The fee paid to the Cleaning Center is 3,150 yen per item.
	23	Pruned Branches	Pruned garden tree branches, bamboo (up to 2m in length and 12cm in diameter)	★Self-delivery

《Other ways to dispose of garbage》

●Large amount of garbage at one time	Large amounts of garbage generated temporarily due to moving, cleaning up, pruning garden trees, etc.	★Bring it to the cleaning center yourself
●General business waste	Waste generated from businesses and workplaces other than industrial waste (e.g., food waste from employees' meals, tea leaves from offices, waste paper, etc.)	★Bring it to the Cleaning Center yourself, or ask a city-approved general waste disposal company to dispose of it.
●Agricultural Plastics	PVC film for agricultural use, plastic for covering greenhouses, rice seedling trays, fertilizer bags, plastic containers, horticultural seedling trays, etc.	●Garbage that cannot be brought to the Cleaning Center. ★The city's Agriculture Department collects them twice a year for a fee. Agriculture Department TEL 72-3111
●Large commercial equipment, propane cylinders, large amounts of vinyl, cars, motorcycles, mud, incineration ashes, large agricultural machinery, construction waste, concrete blocks, concrete, waste oil, oil, chemicals, desktop computers (cathode ray tube type), caterpillar tracks, etc.		●Garbage that cannot be brought to the Cleaning Center. ★Ask a specialist to handle the matter.
