Basic Rules for Garbage Disposal

○Burnable Garbage

Please place burnable garbage in designated garbage bags or attach a disposal ticket and take it to your designated collection point. (Designated bags and disposal tickets can be purchased at supermarkets, drugstores, and home centers.)

○Collection Time

Please bring your waste to the designated collection point by 8:00 AM on the morning of the scheduled collection day.

○Recyclable Waste

For recyclables, please refer to this guidebook and follow the specified sorting and disposal methods at the collection point.

○Large Amounts of Waste

If you have a large amount of household waste at one time due to moving, DIY projects, etc., please bring it directly to the Cleaning Center (Seiso center) or request disposal from a city-authorized contractor.

○Business Waste

Waste generated from shops, offices, or businesses (business-related general waste and industrial waste) cannot be disposed of at residential garbage collection points.

○Maintenance of Collection Points

To ensure smooth collection operations, please cooperate with regular cleaning and weeding of your local garbage collection point.

○Compliance

Waste or recyclables that are not disposed of according to the rules will not be collected.

★ Tips for disposing of "Burnable Waste"

Drain liquid from food waste thoroughly.

Please dispose of snack boxes, tissue boxes, etc., as "Other Paper."

Garbage Disposal Guidelines

● Designated Bags

- Please ensure the weight is within 10 kg for 40L bags and within 5 kg for 20L bags.
- Items that do not fit in designated bags: Please bundle items (up to 50 cm in length) with string, keep the weight within 10 kg, and attach a disposal ticket.

● Note regarding Cooking Oil

- Cooking oil (such as salad oil) should not be disposed of as burnable waste. It can be collected as a recyclable at the "Collection Boxes" located at the City Hall Main Building and each Branch Office.

● Lithium-ion Batteries and Mobile Batteries

- **Never** mix lithium-ion batteries or mobile batteries (power banks) with burnable waste, as they are a serious fire hazard. Please follow the specific disposal rules for these items.

■ Main Burnable Garbage

● Soiled paper



- Tissues
- Paper stained with oil or food
- Laminated paper
- Disposable diapers, etc.

● Leather and cloth items (non-reusable)



- Bags
- Shoes / Footwear
- Soiled cloth products, etc.

● Plastics, Rubber, and Vinyl



- Plastic snack wrappers
- Plastic containers, etc..

● Non-compostable food waste



- Non-reusable wooden products
- Fallen leaves and pruned branches that cannot be processed at home



Size Requirements: If branches exceed the standard size (50 cm in length or 12 cm in thickness), please cut them down and bundle them before disposal.

Large Amounts: If you have a large amount of branches, please cooperate by putting them out over several collection days or bringing them directly to the Cleaning Center (Seiso Center).

Direct Disposal: When bringing branches directly to the Cleaning Center, items up to 2 m in length and 12 cm in thickness can be accepted as Oversized Waste (Sodai Gomi).

©Please remove the caps, rinse the bottles with water, sort them by color, and place them in the containers at the collection station or bring them to the Cleaning Center.

©If caps, labels, or stickers cannot be removed by hand, please leave them attached and dispose of them as is.

■ Colorless Bottles

- Milk, vinegar, dressings, jam, coffee, etc.



■ Brown Bottles

- Beer, energy drinks, medicine, etc.



■ Other Colored Bottles

- Wine, whiskey, shochu, etc.

- Glass tableware, baby bottles, vases, cosmetic bottles, broken glass, etc.



Please put broken bottles and glass in a bag, mark it as "DANGER", and dispose of it in the "Glass" category.

- ◎ Please place them in the buckets at the collection station or bring them to the Cleaning Center.
- ◎ You can dispose of any type of batteries (alkaline batteries, button cell batteries, rechargeable batteries, lithium batteries, etc.).



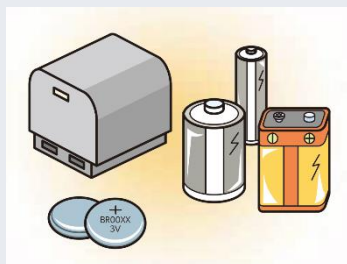
Always separate Lithium-ion batteries and Mobile batteries!

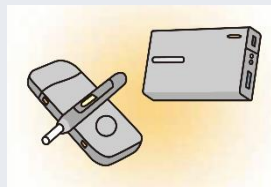

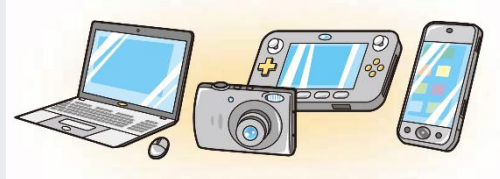

◎ Swollen lithium-ion batteries and mobile batteries are dangerous and may generate heat or catch fire. Please contact the Cleaning Center and bring them in person. (Free collection is available at the 2nd-floor office).



※ Collection of swollen lithium-ion batteries and mobile batteries is limited to household waste. Batteries collected by businesses are not accepted.

- © Remove the labels and caps, rinse with water, crush as much as possible, and place them in the nets at the collection station or bring them to the Cleaning Center.
- © Put the labels in the "Burnable Waste" and place the caps in the small bucket designated for caps.

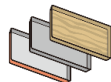

◎ Collection at the stations: Once a month on Cans Day (the _____ of every month).

Check P.14-17 and write in the collection days.

◎ Please sort items by category and bring them to the collection station or the Cleaning Center.

◎ Bundle items that can be tied with string. For small scraps of paper or small boxes that are difficult to tie, please place them in a paper bag.

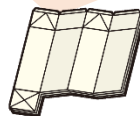

For paper cartons, please wash, open, and dry them. However, cartons with a silver or brown interior should be disposed of as "Burnable Waste."

Sort by type and tie with string.

- ◎ **Collection at the stations: Once a month on Cans Day (the _____ of every month).**
Check P.14-17 and write in the collection days.
- ◎ Place in a clear or semi-transparent bag. Bring to the collection point or cleaning center.
- ◎ Torn items are OK. (Must be clean / No heavy stains)
- ◎ If stains cannot be removed by washing, please dispose of them as "Burnable Waste."

Check P.14-17 and write in the collection days.
- ◎ Rinse with water. Place in the container at the collection point or bring to the Cleaning Center.



Use up the contents completely and puncture a hole in the can.

- Aluminum cans, steel cans, food cans, snack/cookie tins, spray cans, etc.

- Metal caps and lids (from canned coffee, energy drinks, or canned food) should be sorted as "Aluminum/Steel Cans," not as "Other Metals."

- ◎ When bringing items to the collection point, they must be within 50cm on any side and weigh no more than 10kg.

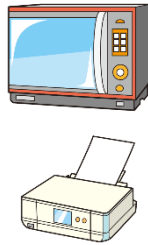

- Apartments/Condos: If you live on the 2nd floor or higher, please place items in the 1st-floor common area.

Disposal Process & Where to Bring Waste

<Disposal Process>

Purchase a Home Appliance Recycling Ticket at the Post Office first, then bring your item to a designated collection point or the Cleaning Center.

(The cost of the recycling ticket varies depending on the item type, manufacturer, and size.)

<Comparison of Fees>

1. Bring to Designated Collection Point yourself: 0 yen (Only the Recycling Ticket fee).
2. Bring to the Cleaning Center: 2,100 yen + Recycling Ticket fee.
3. Request Door-to-Door Collection: 3,150 yen + Recycling Ticket fee.

Pruned Branches and Bamboo

1. Direct Delivery to the Cleaning Center

If you have a large amount or long branches, please bring them directly to the Cleaning Center.

- **Size Limits:** Up to **2 meters in length** and **12 cm in diameter**.
- **Fee:** **157 yen per 10 kg**.
- **Where:** Bring them to the **Cleaning Center**.

2. Disposal at Local Garbage Collection Points

You can put them out at your local collection point if they meet the following conditions:

- **Using Disposal Tickets (Shori-ken):**
 - If branches are up to **50 cm in length** and **12 cm in diameter**, bundle them together.
 - Each bundle must weigh **less than 10 kg**.
 - Attach a **Disposal Ticket (Shori-ken)** to each bundle.
- **Using Designated Bags (Shitei-bukuro):**
 - If you only have a **small amount**, you can put them in the city's **Designated Garbage Bags**.



3. Where to Buy Tickets and Bags

- You can purchase Disposal Tickets and Designated Bags at **supermarkets, drugstores, and home centers**.

Waste for Direct Delivery to the Cleaning Center

- ◎ Large amounts of temporary waste from moving, cleaning out your home, or pruning garden trees
- ◎ Waste that exceeds 50 cm on any side or weighs more than 10 kg

Agricultural Plastics

【Agricultural Plastics】

What is it? It includes plastic films for greenhouses (polyethylene), rice seedling trays, and fertilizer bags.

Disposal Rule: These items **CANNOT** be brought to the Cleaning Center.

City Collection: The **Agricultural Administration Division** conducts paid collections **twice a year**.

Denture Recycling

■ Denture & Dental Metal Recycling

Precious metals from dentures are recycled to support social welfare.

• Items Accepted:

- Dentures
- False teeth / Crowns
- Dental Bridges
- Inlays
- Note: Only items with metal parts are accepted.

• Preparation

1. Clean: Remove any debris or dirt.
2. Disinfect: Soak in boiling water or use a disinfecting denture cleaner.
3. Pack: Put them in a plastic bag before placing them in the box.

Recycling of Small Home Appliances

We promote the recycling of small home appliances to effectively utilize precious resources, such as rare metals found in mobile phones and other electronic devices.

■Collection Box Service

●Small home appliances, such as mobile phones, can be dropped off in collection boxes located at the City Hall and other public facilities.

■Collection at Local Recyclables Stations

●In addition to the collection boxes, household appliances such as electric kettles and rice cookers (including small appliances eligible for box collection) can also be put out as "Other Metals" (Sonota Kinzoku-ru) on designated recyclables collection days.

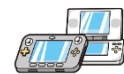

■Warnings

- Protect Your Data:** Please ensure all personal data is erased from devices before recycling.
- No Retrieval:** Once an item is placed in the collection box, it cannot be returned.
- Removable Batteries:** Remove all removable batteries. Dispose of them as "Dry Cell Batteries" (Kan-denchi) on designated recyclables collection days.
- **Built-in Rechargeable Batteries:** For devices with built-in (non-removable) batteries, please discharge them completely before disposal. You do not need to force the battery out.
- Disks (CDs, DVDs, etc.):** Items like CDs and DVDs are not accepted in the recycling box. Please dispose of them as "Burnable Garbage"

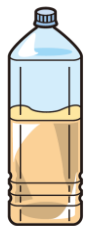
How to Dispose of Used Cooking Oil

Used Cooking Oil

1. Filter out food residue using kitchen paper or a strainer.
2. Pour the cooled oil into a plastic (PET) bottle.
3. Close the cap tightly before bringing it to the box.

Unopened Expired Oil

- Please bring it as is without opening the bottle.
